


# **Match Date**

# Parking at the Range

**Parking and Motorized Vehicles** – Competitor vehicles are restricted to the designated parking areas (See Below Diagram). The designated parking area is the gravel parking lot inside the main gate, and the grass area between the parking lot and high-power berm. See range map for details. No competitor vehicles may be parked directly in front of bays. Small vehicles may be used on gravel surfaces for transport between bays **with Match Director Approval only.**

# Range Facilities

Mill Creek Rifle Club is a private range. Please be aware that the range is open to its members during the match as well as the potential for other matches on other bays at the range. Please be respectful of members of Mill Creek Rifle Club. Any range that is not listed as part of the match is unavailable to competitors and is not part of the match. These ranges are reserved for Members of the Club. There is no fire function, testing, or practice bay.

**Range Entrance:** There is a gated entrance at the range. On Friday, Aug 30th, we will have someone at the gate during the day to allow competitors entry to observe or walk the stages, provided no squad is actively shooting.

The gate will also be open to competitors during registration times:

Friday, August 29th: 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM
 Saturday, August 30th: 6:30 AM - 7:45 AM

If you need to leave the range at other times and require re-entry, please inform the Match Director before you leave. Upon exiting, the gate will open automatically as you drive up to it.

For any issues, please contact the Match Director.

Restrooms: There are portable restrooms available in various locations around the Range for use.

**Water:** There will be water bottles available throughout the range for competitors. Please stay Hydrated. Please note: Any running water on the range is **non-potable water** is not treated to drinking water standards and is **not meant for human consumption**.

**Drugs and Alcohol:** Alcohol and recreational drugs may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors violating this policy will be disqualified and asked to leave the range.

**Cold Range**: This match is a cold range. Firearms may only be handled in safety areas or under the direct supervision of an RO. Handling firearms in a parking area is unsafe gun handling. Competitors arriving with a loaded firearm are required to contact a match official for escort to an unloading area. Bays and berms not part of the match are not to be used for handling firearms, including for loading/unloading, except under the supervision of a Mill Creek Rifle Club member.

**Safety Areas**: Marked safety areas are located around the range for dry fire practice and gun repair, etc. No ammunition (dummy ammo or snap caps are considered ammo) may be handled in any safe area. Competitors are required to be entirely within the marked safe area boundaries when handling firearms.

# **Match Briefing**

Rules: This match will be run under the latest edition of the USPSA Handgun Rulebook.

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be individual members of USPSA, or a current member of their IPSC region. A competitor who presents proof of online registration and payment as a new member prior to entering the competition is considered a member for the purpose of this rule.

#### **Entering the Course of Fire:**

- DO NOT ACTIVATE ANY MOVING PROPS
- On Friday August 29th, if no competitors are shooting, preparing to shoot, or scoring the stage, the Range Master has approved registered competitors only to enter or move through a course of fire.

**DQ Policy**: In the unfortunate event a competitor is disqualified from the match, the Range Master will discuss the DQ with the competitor.

**Eye and Ear Protection**: All competitors and spectators must wear eye and ear protection while on the line or on the range while shooting is taking place. Eye protection must be worn at all times by everyone on the range.

**Spectators**: If you have friends or family coming to watch the match, they are required to have appropriate eye and ear protection. Any children are the responsibility of the parent and are not allowed to run around unsupervised.

Lost Brass: This is a lost brass match.

**Scheduling**: All stages will be shot in order. There will be no skipping stages by any squad unless directed by Match Director or Range Master.

**Calibration**: If a popper fails to fall when hit, the shooter must challenge the popper during scoring. If the popper fails and requires re-calibration, a reshoot will be required for the stage. Please see the current USPSA Rulebook on Popper Calibration for more information.

**Arbitrations**: Arbitrations are initiated with the presentation of a \$100 cash fee and the completed arbitration form delivered to the Range Master. Forms are available from the match director or statistician. We will be utilizing Electronic Score Logs. There will be a 15 Minute Arbitration Period once all stages are complete.

**Set Steel and Tape Targets**: Competitors are expected to stay together as a squad to tape, reset steel, and help maintain efficiency on each stage.

**Inspection**: When the entire squad is assembled at a bay, a brief stage walkthrough will be given, followed by a brief inspection and question period. After that point, shooters may only walk the stage if they are the next shooter while the previous shooter's targets are being scored.

**Tear-Down**: Competitors will not tear down or remove any part of a stage unless directed by the Match Director. Stage tear down will happen at a later time.

**Scores –** Scoring of the match will be done utilizing PractiScore and will be available shortly after completion of the match. Each competitor will be sent a score log for each stage via the registered email address. It is strongly advised that each competitor check the accuracy of their scores with the scoring RO prior to leaving the stage. Each competitor is required to approve his/her score before leaving the stage. This approval is accepting that the score in the tablet is accurate. If a shooter leaves a stage without approving the score, it will be deemed accepted by the shooter as an accurate score.

**Check In** - Competitors need to check in prior to the start of the match. Check in is available outside the club house Friday Aug 29th from 4PM to 6PM and Saturday August 30th from 7AM until the shooter's meeting at 7:45 AM.

**Shooter's Meeting -** Shooter's meeting and equipment inspection will be held by the CRO at the first stage of the day for each squad at 7:45AM on Saturday, August 30th. Competitors will start shooting at 8am on Saturday.

**RO/Staff Shoot** - RO's and staff will shoot the match on Friday August 29th. Competitors may be permitted to shoot with Staff with Match Director approval only.

**Squadding -** We are planning on 10 squads of competitors on Saturday. There will be no breaks in the shooting except for lunch by squad. Squadding is by self-squadding on Practiscore. Squad order will compete in order alphabetically based off of last name. The First Shooter of a stage will rotate to last shooter on the next stage based on this order.

**Changing Divisions** - If you need to change divisions, you must let the statistician know at check in. We will run the classification update from USPSA on Thursday August 29th.

**Chronograph** – Competitors will report to the chronograph at the scheduled time for their squads. If you fail to report to the chronograph for the scheduled test or after a random sampling, your scores will be removed from the match. At the chronograph station, do not handle your gun until instructed by the CRO. Certified Match Ammunition must be declared at registration, the Certified Ammunition Declaration completed and turned in with your eight sample rounds. Competitors declaring Certified Match Ammunition will still follow the Chronograph procedures.

**Awards** – Division, Class and Category winners will be announced after the match. Mock Awards will be available for photo opportunities and personalized awards will be delivered or shipped to recipients after the event.

Division Awards will be given out for each division with more than 5 competitors. We will follow the 5/7/9 Rule for Divisions for 1st-3rd Place Division Awards.

Class Awards will be given out for M, A, B, C, D Classes with more than 5 competitors in a class within a Division. We will follow the 5/7/9 Rule for Classes to award 1st-3rd Place Awards in each class.

Category Award will be given out for Categories that have 5 or more competitors in that category.

Food - Lunch will be included. Menu is still being confirmed.

**T-Shirts** - Match shirts that competitors have purchased may be picked up at registration. Shirts were not included in the base price of the Match.

**Prize Drawing** – Our sponsors have donated prizes for a random drawing by Squad. Every Squad will stop at the Prize Table during the flow of the match for a chance at a random draw prize. Staff will have a chance at the Prize Table at the completion of the Match.

Squads are expected to break for lunch when directed by the Match Director. Lunch is expected to be staggered between 11:30 and 1:00 PM to try and limit the downtime.












